Ihre Anfahrt it unserer HVV:

S-Bahn 1 oder 11: Station Rübenkamp: Via this connection you can also reach our institute comfortably from the **airport** and from **Hamburg main station**. **Bus lines 20, 26, 28, 118, 172** also stop here.

Please take the footpath next to AK Barmbek (on the right) along the canal. You will come directly to the building where the Medosophos Institute is located. The entrance to the Medosophos Institute is on the other side, so please take the footpath past the building on the left and go right through the small gate into the traffic circle. Through the main entrance you will enter the atrium. On the opposite side (on the right) is the Medosophos Institute. You go through the round arch and then it is the right door..

Bus: Stop "AK Barmbek", lines 7, 28, 172 as well as night bus 607

This is the bus stop directly in front of the building. You go to the south entrance AK Barmbek and keep immediately left. Go through the gateway into the traffic circle and stand directly in front of the main entrance. When you enter the atrium through the main entrance, the Medosophos Institute is located on the opposite side. You go through the round arch and then it is the right door.

BY CAR::

The main access to the institute is on Fuhlsbüttler-Strasse between Nordheimstrasse and Hebebrandstrasse. At the bus stop. Please do not park in the traffic circle, but find a parking space nearby. A parking disc is needed for most parking spaces - 2 hours are free of charge.

You can use the parking garage from Ak Barmbek, which is accessible from Rübenkamp-Strasse. Use is free for the first 30 minutes, then there is a charge of €2 per hour for the first two hours; €1.50 per hour thereafter. The maximum daily charge is 10,- €. In addition, there is a cab rank at AK Barmbek as well as reserved parking spaces for the car-sharing service Car2Go.
